

32nd Annual Georgia Marble Festival Rules & Regulations

The Georgia Marble Festival Committee, the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce and any and all persons, property owners, suppliers, volunteers and entities connected with the 2012 Georgia Marble Festival are not liable for damages, injury or loss to any person or goods from any cause whatsoever. All Vendors, their heirs, administrators, and executors do hereby waive and release all of the above named from any and all claims or damages of whatever arising out of the vendors' participation in the 2012 Georgia Marble Festival. The Georgia Marble Festival Committee reserves the right to change/edit these Rules & Regulations at any time. Vendors who have submitted applications will be notified of any Rules & Regulation changes after the time of submission.

Vendors must exhibit for the entire show. **Early breakdown will not be permitted.** There is no rain date-come prepared rain or shine. Set-up is allowed during allotted times only. Booths must be set-up and ready for business by 9:30 am on Saturday and 9:00 am on Sunday. Booth must always be manned during festival hours. If you miss the gate closing at 9:30 am on Saturday, you may set-up Sunday beginning at 7:30 am and be ready for business by 9:30 am. Vendors are responsible for setting up booth and collecting sales tax. Vendors are responsible for cleanup of area. **There will be a \$25 late fee applied to any booth application received after the September 1, 2012 deadline. All fees must be paid prior to Set Up on Friday October 5, 2012.**

To be considered an Arts & Crafts booth, all items sold inside the [art and craft booths](#) must be hand made or natural products. These items must be either personally hand-made by the Vendor, or personalized by the Vendor or their representative. These rules will be strictly enforced!

Retail items will be allowed at the Georgia Marble Festival. Retail items will be pre-screened for appropriateness for a Fall Festival. Food items are allowed at the Georgia Marble Festival, these items will be pre-screened. We do not allow multiple vendors to serve like items, unless listed in the Approved List of Side Items.

No promotional products or materials will be allowed to be distributed or sold. No clothing items may be sold or distributed that have advertisements for any causes, businesses or products on them.

No political material or fund raising for causes will be allowed inside the arts & crafts or retail booth area.

Music is restricted to the Entertainment Stage only, with the exception that a vendor booth is selling musical instruments.

Acceptance letters will be mailed promptly after the September 1 deadline.

Food booths may be assigned a specific time to be here. That is determined by vendor's set-up.

Only 20oz. Coca Cola products are to be sold. These must be purchased through the Pickens County Chamber of Commerce.

The Marble Festival Committee holds the right to remove from our mailing list vendors who display, or have displayed in the past, unprofessional behavior.

The Marble Festival Committee holds the right to remove any vendor from the Marble Festival who does not adhere to the above rules & regulations.

Booth assignments, set up instructions, & parking information will be given at the time of Vendor Check-In.
